- (3) There will be no violation of correlative rights by the granting of said application.



- (1) The drilling of a well for Drilling Unit #40 in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 3, Township 21 South, Range 7 East, SLM, and
- (2) The drilling of a well in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 7 East, SLM, Emery County, Utah, for Drilling Unit #43.


