FINDINGS

NOW THEREFORE, the Board having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits reviewed in said hearing and being fully advised in the premises, now makes and enters the following:

1. This Board in Cause No. 13-3 conducted a hearing on the application of Burton W. Hancock. Said hearing, dated September 25,

1980 in Salt Lake City, Utah resulted in the establishment of two new drilling units of 320 acres each consisting of the following described acreage in Township 17 South, Range 25 East, S.L.M., Grand County, Utah:

Drilling Unit No. 1

N½ Sec. 5

Drilling Unit No. 2

S½ Sec. 5

Said Order further specified that the permitted well location for Drilling Unit No. 1 shall be in the center of the NE¼ and for the Drilling Unit No. 2 in the center of the SW¼.

2. From said testimony and exhibits the Applicant demonstrated the only feasible location for the well in the N½ of said Section 5 was on the San Arroyo Ridge which location is 1,860 feet from the north line and 1,760 feet from the west line of said section.

3. Sufficient evidence now bein available upon which to reach a decision, the Board issues the following:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THIS BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

The permitted well location for Drilling Unit No. 1 (N½ of said Section 5, Township 17 South, Range 25 East, S.L.M.) is at a location described as being 1,832 feet from the north line and 1,756 feet from the west line of said section.

Said well designated as the Hancock Federal No. 1 Well is hereby designated as the Unit Well for said Drilling Unit No. 1.
