- 1) Established 320-acre drilling and spacing units for the following described lands, Summit County, Utah:

Sec. 35: All

Township 3 North, Range 7 East
Sec. 2: All Sec. 3: All

for the production of gas from the Twin Creek Formation as defined in Schulumberger's Borehold Compensated Sonic Log for the 34-1 well is that stratigraphic interval from 6440 feet to 7958 feet, subsurface.


- 2) Provided that the permitted well location for each drilling unit of 320 acres be 990' from the boundary of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and at least 990' from the boundary of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the governmental section.

is hereby extended to include gas produced from the Nugget Formation as defined in Shulumberger's Dual Laterolog-MSFL for Amoco's Island Ranching #2 Well as that stratigraphic interval from 7020 feet to 8170 feet, subsurface.


